#### **Adoption of the previous minutes:**

#### **Reports:**

Trustee report – 8.8 Billion 2023/2024 budget and increase of 430 million. It cost 44 million per day that kids are in school in Alberta. 820 million over 3 years for teachers, 126 million for staff support, 80 million for increased costs such as utilities. Bussing transportation changing to less than 1km distance for Kindergarten to Grade 6 and grades 7 – 11 will include less than 2km distance for free bussing. 47 million for teacher learning and improvement, 110 million for academic challenges and mental health.

Capital project we should hear something by the end of the week early next week in regard to the construction budget.

Prairie Rose school district was commended for Vocational and Apprenticeship one of the only boards commended.

Fire Fighter and Rescue will be offered as an Academy through Prairie Rose. Student will be able to receive Level 1 in Grade 11 and Level 2 in Grade 12. The structure has not been confirmed but will likely be offered as an entire year program including field training potentially over summer months. Upon Grade 12 graduation students that completed Level 1 & 2 are employable.

Council of Councils meeting on March 14<sup>th</sup> need to go to pre-election to get our strategic planning.

### **Admin Report:**
