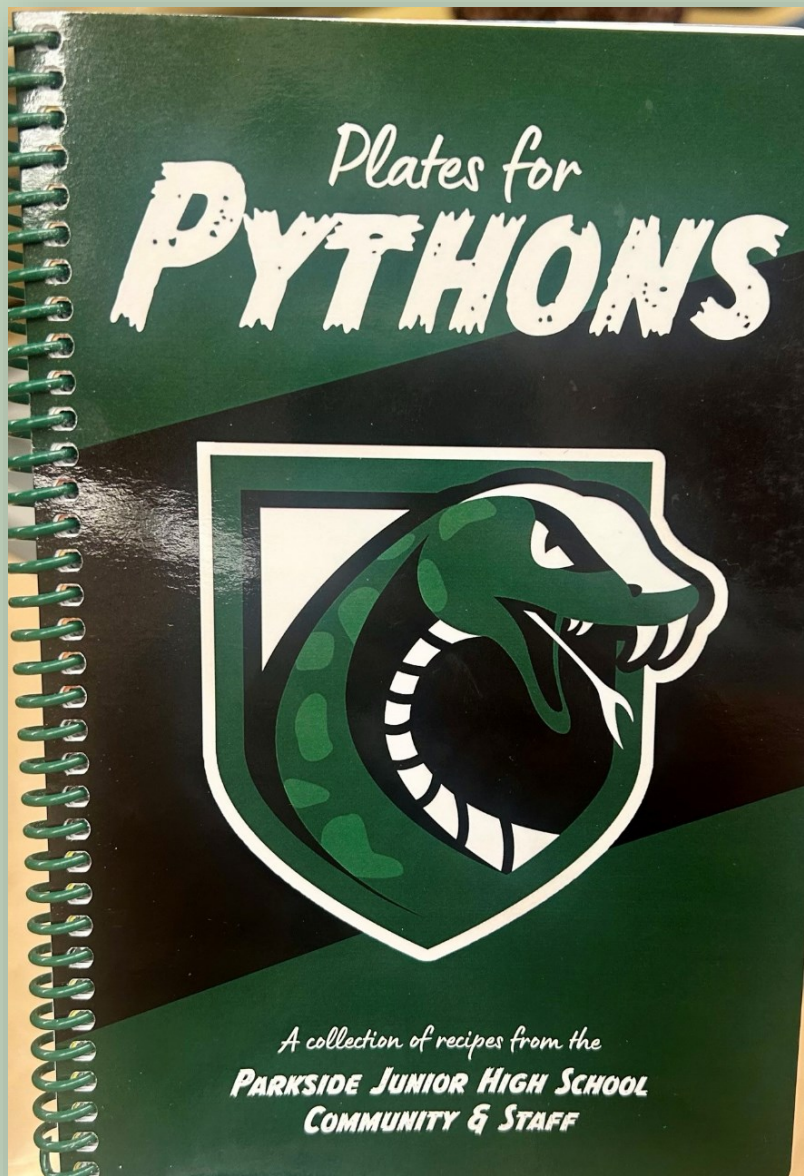

**South Alberta
School of Trades**



What would this **look like** for my child?

- This 3 to 4-year program begins in grade ten and finishes with students completing their first-year Registered Apprenticeship.
- Students take one dual-credit course in grade 10 and another in grade 11 taught by college instructors.
- Students will be connected to work placement opportunities.
- Students also earn additional CTS credits related to career preparation and safety.

What is **dual-credit**?

- Students in year 1 and 2 earn 5 30-level high school credits towards graduation AND 4 MHC "Open Studies" transferable credits that can be put towards a diploma, degree or another credential.

South Alberta School of Trades

Year 1

- Students are selected based on successful applications and family interviews
- Students take **TRAD100**; a MHC course that explores seven different trades:
 - carpentry, steamfitter/pipefitter, welding, automotive service technician, heavy duty equipment technician, power engineering, and electrical
- Students will present themselves to industry partners at a Spring hiring draft.
- Students will begin earning Work Experience credits and gain job experience during the summer.

Year 2

- Students will choose a cluster consisting of two trades to gain more experience in those trades:
 - **TRAD111** Transportation. Automotive Service Technician (AST) and Heavy Equipment Technician (HET)
 - **TRAD 112** Plant & Steam. Steamfitter/Pipefitter and Power Engineering
 - **TRAD 113** Construction I. Plumbing and Electrical
 - **TRAD 114** Construction II. Carpentry and Welding
- By the end of year 2, students should be registered in the **Registered Apprenticeship Program** or **plan to do Pre-employment in year 3.**

Both Years 1 & 2

- Students complete theory delivered through MHC Blackboard specific to each trade
- Students are transported to the college approximately every other Friday to conduct a full day of lab work based on the theory they learned in that trade.
- Students earn **dual credit**. This means upon successful completion of the course, they will earn **5 30 level high school credits** and **4 post-secondary credits**
- Students will earn **additional CTS credits**

Year 3

- Students accumulate apprenticeship hours in the summer going into grade 12 and throughout their grade 12 year
- By the time students graduate they have completed their first-year technical training (8-10 week full day courses) at the college and written their first-year exam
 - Flexible scheduling that involves finishing high school courses by the end of the first semester or adding a 4th year to their program

Pathway considerations

Each student will design an individual pathway to complete their first-year apprenticeship. Considerations include:

- How many high school courses a student wants to take
- The extra-curricular activities a student is in
- Where a student lives
- The amount of apprenticeship hours a student can accumulate

More Info

- The cost of the grade 10 program is \$600.00
- There is a maximum capacity of 48 students. Incoming grade 10s will be chosen first.

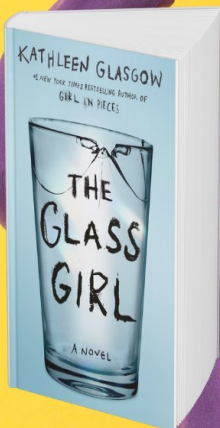

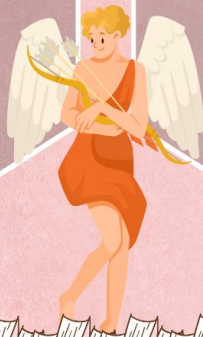
